

Dispensing/Administration of Drugs

Prescription Medications

Prescription medications will be given <u>only</u> if the following requirements are met.

- 1. Written permission from the parent or guardian is in the academy office.
- 2. Written authorization from the physician is in the academy office. The pharmacy labeled bottle cannot be used as the physician's written authorization.
- 3. The medication is provided by the parent in an individual pharmacy labeled bottle for the student who is to receive it.

Non-prescription Medications

Non-prescription medications will be given <u>only</u> if the following requirements are met.

- 1. Written permission from the parent or guardian is in the academy office.
- 2. The medication is provided <u>by the parent</u> in an individual pharmaceutical company labeled bottle.

Please note, if your child comes to the academy office to request Advil or Tylenol, he/she will be given the medication <u>only</u> if the above requirements are met. FRBA will not provide medication for students.
